You have been referred to **Allergy & Asthma of Southern Indiana, P.C.** Your evaluation may involve skin testing for allergies.

- Some medicines for nausea, ulcers or gastroesophageal reflux disease (GERD) may also interfere with skin testing and should be held if possible i.e.: Axid, Pepcid, Tagamet and Zantac.
- Decongestants, steroid nasal sprays and asthma inhalers should be continued.

The following medicines may interfere with skin testing and should not be taken for 1 week before your appointment. The following list is not totally inclusive. If you have any questions, feel free to call our office at 812-334-1198.
