Beta Blockers

Betapace or Betapace AF (sotalol)	Lopressor (metoprolol tartrate)
Blocadren (timolol)	Normodyne (labetalol)
Brevibloc (esmolol)	Sectral (acebutolol)
Cartrol (carteolol)	Sorine (sotalol)
Coreg (carvedilol)	Tenormin (atenolol)
Corgard (nadolol)	Toprol or Toprol-XL (metoprolol)
Inderal, Inderal-LA or InnoPran XL (propranolol)	Trandate (labetalol)
Kerlone (betaxolol)	Visken (pindolol)
Levatol (penbutolol)	Zebeta (bisoprolol fumarate)

Beta Blockers with Diuretics

Inderide LA, Inderide-40/25 or Inderide-80/25 (propranolol & HCTZ)
Lopressor Hydrochlorothiazide (metoprolol & HCTZ)
Tenoretic 100 or Tenoretic 50 (atenolol & chlorthalidone)
Timolide 10-25 (timolol & HCTZ)
Ziac (bisoprolol & HCTZ)

Betimol (timolol hemihydrate)
Betoptic or Betoptic S (betaxolol hydrochloride)

Ocupress (carteolol hydrochloride)
OptiPranolol (metipranolol)
